Important notice to junior members 16 years of age and older!

The rules were voted on and changed at the November 2009 meeting that would require junior members 16 years of age and older to fulfill 24 work hours or be assessed the same monies that a regular member is assessed for not fulfilling work hours. In other words if you are a 16 year old or older junior member and you don't do 24 work hours by Oct. 31st. of 2011 you will be charged \$5.00 for every hour less than 24.
