The steep, trash-strewn slope along Devil's Den Road was no match for a small, dedicated group of nine volunteers on May 8th. This was the second cleanup organized at the dumpsite. The first was held in Fall 2009, and volunteers removed 385 tires from the slope and from another site farther up the road. This time around, the hardworking volunteers collected a portion of the trash and removed the remaining tires. Due to the steep terrain, Hanover Township secured a tow truck donation by Green's Towing to winch up the collected tires. Most of the volunteers were members of the Paris Sportsmen's Club, and one brought two ATV's to help pull up some of the trash.

The illegal dumpsite is located in the ecologically and historically significant Kings Creek greenway area. Kings Creek offers the only cold water fishery in Washington County, provides many fishing opportunities, and boasts impressive features. It is also home to many unique flora and fauna. Future cleanups will be held to remove the remaining items. An adopter is being sought to ensure that it stays trash free.
